Free* Recycling Event in St. Charles on Saturday 9/13/14 Electronics, Books, Liquid Latex Paint & Document Shredding

The Kane County Recycles Event on Saturday 9/13/14, between 8am and 12noon, will be held at 540 S Randall in St. Charles. Please do not arrive early.

Recycle ELECTRONICS like computers, keyboards, laptops, printers, televisions (any size or age), stereos, cell phones, microwaves, Christmas lights, and more. We unload for you! A complete list of accepted items, and more information can be found at <u>www.countyofkane.org</u> /recycling under "Electronics Recycling." We take BOOKS of any age and condition for reuse or recycling.

Liquid LATEX PAINT is the only item that has a recycling fee* per container, payable by the resident

with cash or check. It is \$1.50 per pint and \$2.50 per gallon. Latex paint is non-toxic but difficult to dispose of because you have to dry it out before placing it in your landfill trash. However, it can be easily recycled into new products with no drying out necessary! No oil based product will be accepted.

Bring your DOCUMENTS in paper bags or boxes. Limit is 150 lbs. (4-6 boxes). This is for residents only. No documents from businesses please. More guidelines can be found at www.countyofkane.org/recycling under "Document Shredding."

We do not accept hazardous waste or large household appliances like washers and refrigerators.
