

## 2023 Kane County Asphalt Rejuvenator Project

June 2, 2023 - Kane County will begin applying an asphalt sealer/rejuvenator on roads that have been resurfaced within the last two year, starting the week of June 5, 2023, weather permitting. The process will involve applying the rejuvenator liquid, allowing the liquid to cure, placing sand on the treated roads for traction, and then sweeping up the excess material. Pavement preservation techniques utilize lower cost maintenance improvements conducted early in the life cycle of the asphalt pavement by reducing the water penetration that leads to freeze/thaw damage and preventing oxidation of the asphalt material. Please exercise caution while traveling through the work zone, watch for equipment, workers and stay off of the treated roadway until allowed by flaggers.

Work is expected to occur from the south end of the county progressing north. Construction work hours will be from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday for approximately three to four weeks, weather permitting.

The roads will remain open during treatment, but will be reduced to one lane of travel using flaggers and temporary daily lane closures.

Motorists should expect delays while traveling through the work areas, consider alternate routes and expect additional commute time. Motorists are asked to reduce their speed, watch for construction workers and vehicles entering and leaving the site and obey flaggers and traffic control devices. It is illegal to talk or text on a cell phone while driving.
