



Community COVID Vaccination Clinic at Aurora Farmer's Market Saturday

July 14, 2021 – The Kane County Health Department (KCHD) and the Illinois Department of Public Health will provide COVID vaccines at the Aurora Farmers Market, 65 S. Water St., Aurora on Saturday, July 17 from 8 a.m. to Noon.

No ID is required. No appointment is necessary. KCHD will have Janssen and Pfizer vaccines available for administration. Vaccinations are available for all persons 12 and older.
