Embark on a Family Biking Adventure along the Fox River with a Naturalist

GENEVA, IL — Bring the whole family on a naturalist-guided bike tour along the picturesque Fox River.

The Family Biking Adventure will occur on Sunday, Sept. 10, from 10 a.m. - noon, starting at Les Arends Forest Preserve in Batavia. The leisurely 8-mile ride will begin by heading south on the Fox River Trail, leading participants into the village of North Aurora. Crossing the river, the adventure continues through Glenwood Park Forest Preserve and into charming downtown Batavia.

Throughout the journey, a Forest Preserve District naturalist will make stops along the way to interpret the natural and cultural history of the forest preserves. Participants can soak in the beauty of the river and its surroundings, while learning about the diverse flora and fauna that call this area home.

As the bike tour reaches its midway point in Batavia, families will have the opportunity to treat themselves to a refreshing ice cream at the Batavia Creamery before cycling back to our starting point.

Participants must provide their own bikes and wear helmets throughout the tour. All riding will be done on paved surfaces. Les Arends Forest Preserve is located at 2S731 Route 31, Batavia.
