- EVERY ITEM LISTED BELOW IS <u>REQUIRED</u> UNLESS LABELED OTHERWISE; ANY OMMISSION OF DOCUMENTATION WILL RESULT IN AN INCOMPLETE APPLICATION SUBMITTAL AND MAY DELAY THE PETITION REVIEW AND APPROVAL PROCESS.
- EVERY SUBMITTAL DOCUMENT MUST BE <u>DATED</u> AND THE SUBJECT PROPERTY <u>PARCEL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER</u> SHALL BE INDICATED ON ALL SUBMITTED PLANS.

GENERAL DOCUMENTATION

- 2. Special Use Permit Findings of Fact Worksheet
- 3. Project Narrative/ "Commercial Solar Energy Facility Summary"
 - a. A general description of the project including: its approximate overall name plate generating capacity; the potential equipment manufacturer(s); type(s) of solar panels, cells and modules; the number of solar panels, cells and modules; the maximum height of the solar panels at full tilt; the number of substations; a project site plan, project phasing plan and project construction timeline plan; and the general location of the project.
 - b. A description of the (1) APPLICANT (2) PROPERTY OWNER (3) SOLAR OPERATOR and (4) FACILITY OWNER, including their name(s), address(es), phone number(s), and respective business structures.
- 4. Documentation demonstrating land ownership or legal control of the property (Petition Applicant must be the property owner OR have legal control of the property)
- 5. Plat of Survey/ALTA Land Title Survey
- 6. Solar Equipment Manufacturer Specs
- 7. Noise Analysis by a <u>Qualified Professional</u> (Noise levels from Commercial Solar Energy Facilities shall be in compliance with applicable Illinois Pollution Control Board (IPCB) regulations)
- 8. Decommissioning Plan (See Appendix G for Format Guidelines)
- 9. Decommissioning Surety Draft (e.g., draft bond agreement)
- 10. Waiver of Setback Requirements (if applicable)
- 11. Traffic Study (Optional)
- 12. Glare Study (Optional)

- 26. Documentation demonstrating avoidance of protected lands as identified by IDNR and the <u>Illinois Nature Preserve</u> <u>Commission</u> (INPC)
- 27. Written Approval of Roadway Use from the <u>Road District Commissioner and the County Engineer</u> (Any proposed public roads that will be used for construction purposes shall be identified and approved in writing by the respective Road District Commissioner and the County Engineer prior to the granting of the Special Use)
- 28. Structural Engineer's Certificate (Shall be completed by a <u>structural engineer registered in the State of Illinois</u> or by a Professional Engineer with a certification from a structural engineer registered in the State of Illinois and shall certify that the specific soils and subsurface conditions at the site can support the apparatus, given local soil, subsurface and climate conditions)
- 29. FEMA 100-Year Floodplain Map
- 30. Level 1 Wetland Investigation
- 31. Topographical Map of the Subject Property and surrounding area
- 32. Preliminary Farmland Drain Tile Investigation
- 33. Preliminary Stormwater Management Report
